April 17, 2020

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Joint Commission standards require that the following information be shared with the PCPs at the time of the discharge:

- Reason(s) for hospitalization
- Significant findings/events during the inpatient stay
- Procedures performed and care, treatment and services provided
- Patient's condition at the time of discharge
- Information/education provided to the patient and their caregiver

WHAT WE ASK FROM YOU:

- 1. Ensure that hospital records indicate updated PCP contact information.
- 2. Implement effective mechanisms to deliver documented discharge summaries to correct PCPs in a timely manner.
- 3. Ensure that PCPs will have access to this patient discharge information prior to the patient's 14 day follow up visit.
- 4. Educate patients on the importance of sharing their medical information with their PCPs and encourage them to complete a "release of information" form.
