Health Plan of San Joaquin expands member access to flu shots

STOCKTON – Health Plan of San Joaquin has expanded access to all its members to receive the protections of this year's flu shot. Now, any HPSJ member can get a flu shot from any HPSJ contracted provider.

- For members 19 years old and older: Providers will be reimbursed for both the vaccine and administration; members can get the flu vaccine at the doctor's office or pharmacy.
- For children 18 and younger: Providers will be reimbursed only for administration; the vaccine is provided via the Vaccines for Children Program.

For HPSJ members not being seen by their assigned provider, this expanded access applies only to influenza vaccination and not to any additional services and benefits.
