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## LATEST COVID-19 INFORMATION CAMPAIGN FROM HEALTH PLAN OF SAN JOAQUIN – "RECOVERY IS UP TO ALL OF US"

In continuing efforts to inform and protect the health and safety of its members, Health Plan of San Joaquin (HPSJ) is proud to announce their new multi-media campaign to encourage vaccinations against COVID-19 and support the recovery of the entire community beyond the pandemic.
