**Performance Improvement** — Additional incentives can be earned for up to 10 measures that improved at least 3 to 5 percentile points compared to Calendar Year 2023 in the following domains:

- Children's and behavioral health measures: 3 percentile points or more
- All other measures: 5 percentile points or more
