VITA is an IRS initiative offering free basic tax return to qualified individuals. **If you earned less than \$70,000 last year, you may be eligible.**



This service helps low-income individuals, persons with disabilities, the elderly, and limited English speakers file their taxes.



VITA can help you look for tax credits, too. Finding tax credits may help you get a larger return. This can help with basic needs like food, housing and childcare costs.
